3. What is a sentence? What does a sentence need to be complete. (. ! ? Give an example of a sentence using each end mark. ( . ! ? )
4. Share one of the top ten ways to be a good citizen. Explain some ways that you are a good citizen and why this is important.
5. Retell your story that you worked on in class. Explain at least three steps of the writing process.
6. We read the book- *Two of Everything* by Lily Toy Hong. What is the math idea shared in this book? Explain what you would like to be doubled. (You'll be surprised by some of their choices.)
7. In social studies we are working on some map skills. Why is it important to know direction? ( near, far, right, left, north, south, east, and west).
8. What have you learned about air? Tell about the experiments we have done in class.
9. We went for our 2nd observation out at **Brues Woods**. Name some living things you observed out at this site.
