

The students are off to a great start! We are currently working with numbers and greetings with all of the children at their appropriate grade level.

1st Grade

The first graders are working on greetings and feelings. They are asking their friends how they are doing and giving appropriate responses. The "Hola" song is a favorite. We are sure your child would love to sing it for you. Shortly, we will introduce the calendar: days, months and year. They are very excited and eager to learn!

2nd Grade

The second graders reviewed numbers 1-20 quickly and are moving on. We are counting up to 30 and adding on shapes and colors. They are already constructing complete sentences.

3rd Grade

The third graders reviewed numbers 1-30 and will soon count up to 60. They are enthusiastically demonstrating their math skills. We are working on single and double digit math equations learning +, - and =. Shortly we will begin our unit on time.

4th Grade

In fourth grade we have been focusing on numbers 1-100, counting by 10's. We have been playing Jeopardy and Memory. The students are doing a fantastic job thus far. During the week of October 26th we will begin our activities for Day of the Dead. Shortly afterwards we will begin our unit on Spanish speaking countries: location, topography, economy, food and culture.

5th Grade

Finally, our excited 5th graders! Where shall we begin.... The children are currently earning pesetas for the jobs they perform in class. Students are encouraged to volunteer to dress Jorge, read the date, weather and time. The children earn and save the pesetas for market day. At that time they can spend their pesetas on small items: Spanish - English dictionaries, woven bracelets, worry stones and many more items. During the week of October 26th we will begin our celebration for The Day of the Dead. We will read stories and decorate sugar skulls. We are currently working on numbers 1 - 1,000,000.
