

Notice regarding Food Allergies/Eating on the Bus

Dear Parents/Guardians,

There are many students who have allergies to peanuts and tree nuts. Some of these students are highly allergic, and may react to contact with foods containing these ingredients. At school we have made these classrooms peanut and nut-free by requesting that parents of students in these rooms avoid sending in foods containing peanut or tree nut products for snack.

However, on the upcoming second grade field trip, the students will have to eat their snacks on the bus. Eating peanut/nut products on school buses is prohibited not only for the safety of the students on the field trip but also for the safety of students who will be riding the buses home from school later in the day. Please avoid sending **any** peanut/tree nut products with your child for snack the day of the field trip. I realize that this may seem an inconvenience, but it is to protect the health of all students with food allergies.
