NIXON SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL OPENINGS

We Have Openings For TWO Parents!

Do you have an interest in maintaining the high level of education at the Nixon School?

In accordance with the Education Reform Act of 1993, each elementary school in Sudbury is required to create a School Council, consisting of equal numbers of faculty and parents and up to two community members.

Responsibilities: The Council assists the principal in adopting **educational goals** for the school that are consistent with local educational policies and statewide student performance standards, identifying the **educational needs** of students at Nixon, reviewing the annual school building **budget**, and formulating a **school improvement plan**.

Job Description:

- Understand and see the value of the role as an advisor to the Principal.
- Work cooperatively with other key constituency groups of the school community.
- Represent a constituency on the School Advisory Council by actively interacting with said constituency.
- Work towards an understanding of how the school can operate effectively in relationship to the entire school system.
- Understand the role of the community in the educational process.
- See the value of both short term planning and problem-solving and long range planning for the school's future.
- Use personal expertise in an area that will benefit the operation of the school (i.e., organizational skills, programmatic experience, marketing, etc.).

Members are asked to serve a two-year term. There are approximately eight meetings per year, typically held on Thursday afternoons. Members may participate in subcommittee work based on their interest, expertise and time availability. Next years council membership includes Holly Bernene and Maria Behrakis, parent representatives, and Amy Batts, Deana Miller, Megan Roth, and Meghan Ward, teacher representatives.
